A. The CONSUMING PASSION of the Apostle Paul

Philippians 3:7-14

- 1. The surpassing worth of knowing Christ; Philippians 3:8
 - Knowledge alone of Christ does not produce passion for Him. 1 Corinthians 13:2 $\,$
 - Facts of the history of Christ do not produce passion for Him. Luke 24:25-27, 32
 - Knowing Christ produces transformation by Christ: John 3:3; 2 Corinthians 5:17
 - Knowing Christ leads to love for Christ: 1 Peter 1:3-9
- 2. The surpassing worth of knowing Christ experienced

- Surpassing worth in Christ's love John 13:1; Gal. 2:20
- Surpassing worth in Christ's mercy 1 Tim. 1:15-16; Eph. 2:4-5
